
A total of 10,323 transactions amounting to USD 509,678,892.35 were recorded for import transactions.



From 2010 to September 2023, the total number of employment generated by FAB increased by $\mathbf{201.83\%}$

As of **September 2023**, a total of **38,565 workers** were generated, wherein **46.70%** are **female** while **53.30%** are **male**.





48.58% of the total workers generated came from **industrial enterprises**, while **30.79%** from **service providers**, and **20.63%** from **various industries**.

In addition, **70.2%** of the workers are **regular** employees of their respective enterprises.

⁽¹⁾ Metropolitan Areas are defined by the CREATE Law as Metro Cebu, Metro Davao, and the local government units identified as such by the NEDA through laws or executive issuances.

⁽³⁾ The availment of either the Special Corporate Income Tax (SCIT) or Enhanced Deductions (ED) shall be at the option of the EXPORT enterprise. (Based on VETO Message of PRRD dated 26 March 2021)
