A total of 13,932 transactions amounting to USD 612,776,452.63 were recorded for import transactions.



From 2010 to December 2023, the total number of employment generated by FAB increased by 220.07%

As of **December 2023**, a total of **40,895 workers** were generated, wherein **45.28%** are **female** while **54.72%** are **male**.



71.91% of FAB workers are from Mariveles, combined workforce of **21.32%** from other towns in Bataan, and **6.77%** from other provinces of the country.



47.82% of the total workers generated came from **industrial enterprises**, while **33.25%** from **service providers**, and **18.93%** from **various industries**.

In addition, 65.7% of the workers are **regular** employees of their respective enterprises.

The FAB is situated at the southern tip of Bataan Peninsula at the south central portion of Mariveles Municipality. As stated in the FAB Master Plan, its effective jurisdiction covers 1,686.90 hectares, occupying portions of five (5) Barangays: Alasasin, BASECO Country (NASSCO), Malaya, Maligaya and Sisiman.*

Based on the 2020 Census of Population (POP CEN 2020), the growth rate of Bataan for the year 2010 – 2020 is 2.18 with 853,373 total number of population.*
