

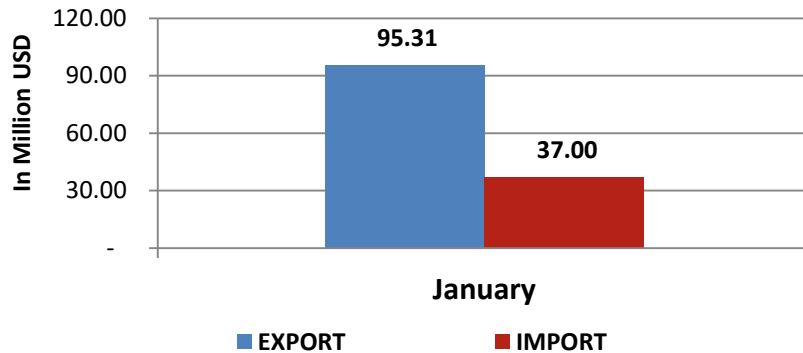

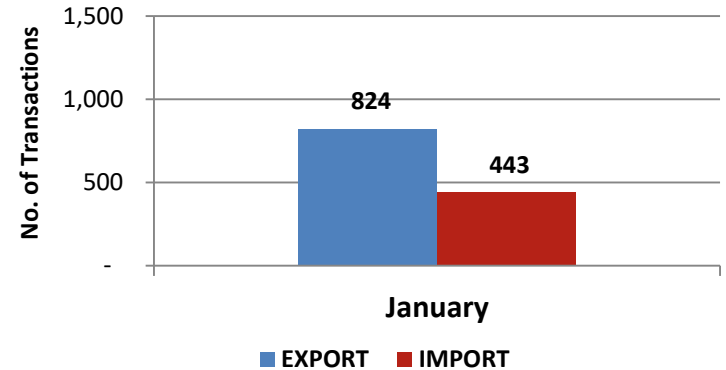

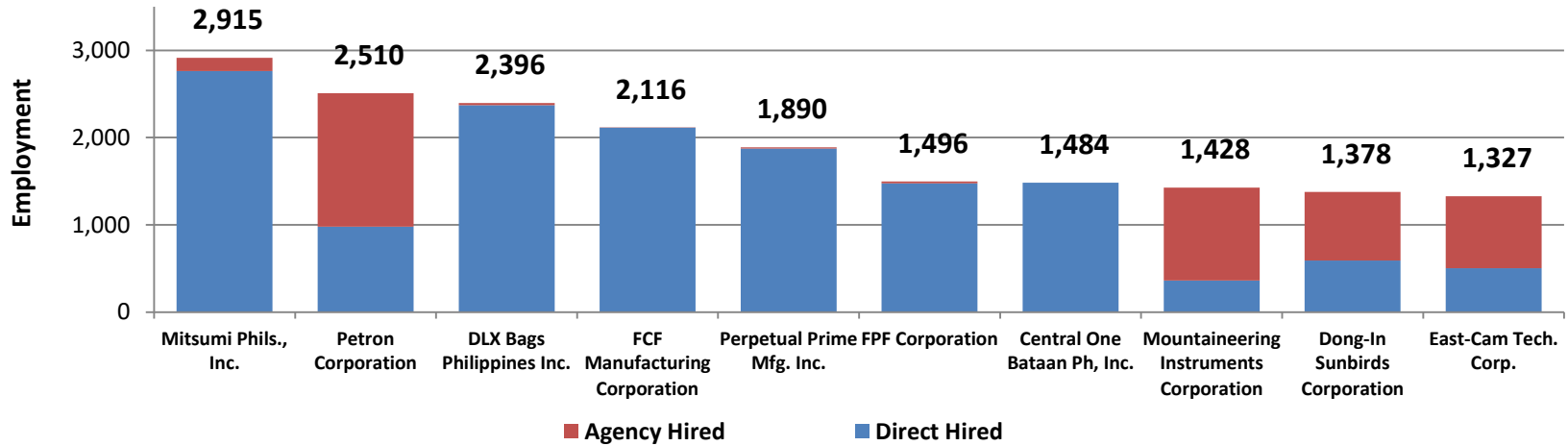

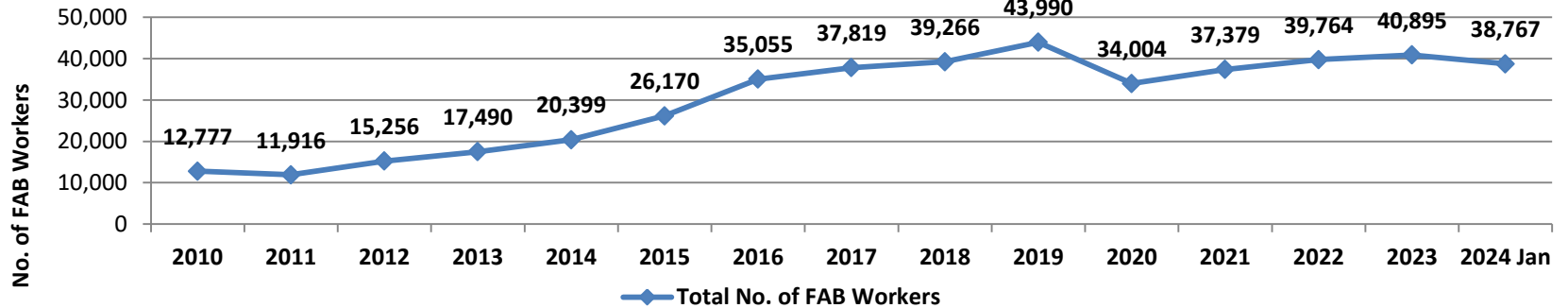

FAB Workers



From **2010 to 2024 January**, the total number of employment generated by FAB increased by **203.41%**

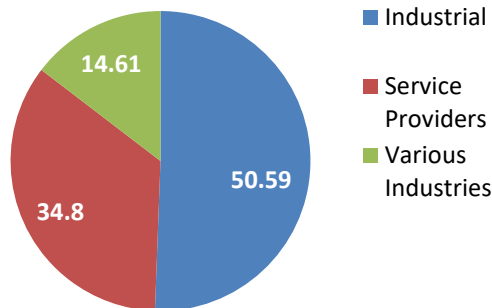
As of **January 2024**, there's a total of **38,767** employed workers, wherein **45%** are **female** while **55%** are **male**.

75.74% of FAB workers are from Mariveles, followed by **17.19%** from other towns in Bataan, and **7.07%** from outside Bataan or other provinces.

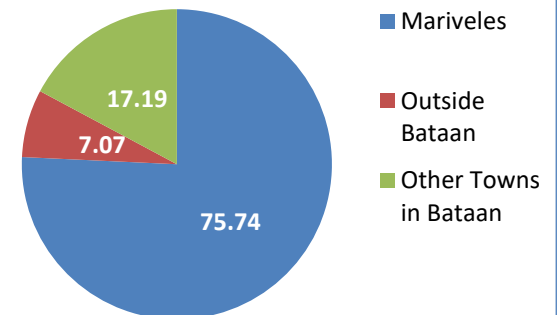
In addition, **50.59%** of the total number of workers generated came from **industrial enterprises**, while **34.8%** from **service providers**, and **14.61%** from **various industries**.

66.4% or **25,751** of the workers are **regular** employees of their respective enterprises.

DEMOGRAPHY

The FAB is situated at the southern tip of Bataan Peninsula at the South central portion of Mariveles Municipality. As stated in the FAB Master Plan, its effective jurisdiction covers 1,686.90 has., occupying portions of five (5) Barangays: Alasasin, BASECO Country (Nassco), Malaya, Maligaya and Sisiman.*

Based on the 2020 Census of Population (POPCEN 2020), the growth rate of Bataan for the year 2010 – 2020 is 2.18 with 853,373 total number of population. The municipality of Mariveles ranked the highest number of population in Bataan with 149,879 total number of population.*

⁽¹⁾ Metropolitan Areas are defined by the CREATE Law as Metro Cebu, Metro Davao, and the local government units identified as such by the NEDA through laws or executive issuances.

⁽²⁾ Industries under each tier shall be specifically identified in the SIPP.

⁽³⁾ The availment of either the Special Corporate Income Tax (SCIT) or Enhanced Deductions (ED) shall be at the option of the EXPORT enterprise. (Based on VETO Message of PRRD dated 26 March 2021)

⁽⁴⁾ For Domestic Enterprises, ED is the only incentive they could afford after ITH.
